#### GARDEN LIGHTING RELAY SAFTEY PROCEDURE





You will need to locate the Main Control box which is normally situated above the bay behind the displays.

If you can not locate this please ask the Electrical Team Members for assistance.

Once you have located the Control Box you will need to which off the power to the bay.

You may need to play around with switches to find the correct one as they are not always in the right order as you can see in the bottom photo.

Once you have switched of the power to the bay proceed to the bay.

Please switch any other lights back on again.









#### GARDEN LIGHTING RELAY SAFTEY PROCEDURE



Before you start to remove any displays you will need to locate the cable to the displays and disconnect this. It easily pulls apart and as you would of already switched off the power there is no chance live lines.

Once you have disconnected the power cable you can now commence to take down the displays.







#### GARDEN LIGHTING RELAY DISPLAY REMOVAL PROCEDURE

#### Please note that we are only removing the bottom row of displays.

This will require 2 people as it can be tricky to remove on your own and is not recommended.

To remove the displays you simply pick up each individual section of display (check to see if they have been screwed down) if so grab a screwdriver from the store and unscrew the displays.

Once you have removed the bottom row of displays them on a pallet and let the Store know that it is there responsibility to throw them out.
