1 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Holman Industries is a family business, based in Perth WA, that was originally established in 1966. The company is focused on providing products for irrigation, watering, plumbing, civil, garden lifestyle and garden lighting.

Elysee Irrigation Ltd is a Cyprus based manufacturer of plastics pipeline components and supplies Holman Industries with a range of compression fittings for polyethylene pipes.

This appraisal is for a range of PN16 Elysee polypropylene (PP) compression fittings for PE pipes, manufactured in conformance with AS/NZS 4129:2020 *Fittings for polyethylene (PE) pipes for pressure applications.*

The range of fittings includes couplings, tees, elbows, adaptors and end plugs in sizes from DN 16 to DN 110. See Section 4 and Appendix A for further details of the range.

The compression joint is assembled to PE pipe without removing the nut from the body. After the pipe is pushed into the fitting the nut is tensioned to affect a seal.

Both Holman and Elysee hold ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System Licences.

The PP compression fittings have ISO Type 5 StandardsMark Product Certification to AS/NZS 4129:2020 *Fittings for polyethylene (PE) pipes for pressure applications.*

This Appraisal has determined that the Elysee range of PP fittings, as detailed in this report, meet the requirements of WSA PS 208 – *Plastics Fittings for Pressure Applications with PE Pipe – Drinking Water, Non-Drinking Water Supply and Sewerage* and are considered as 'fit-for-purpose'.

1.1 Recommendations

It is recommended that WSAA members, subject to any specific requirements of the member, accept or authorise the Elysee range of PP compression fittings as detailed in this report for use in in drinking and non-drinking water supply and pressure sewerage networks, provided they are designed and installed in accordance with applicable WSAA Codes and the manufacturer's requirements.

2 THE APPLICANT

The Applicant is Holman Industries.

2.1 The Supplier

Holman Industries is a family business, based in Perth WA that was originally established in 1966. The company is focused on providing products for irrigation, watering, plumbing, civil, garden lifestyle and garden lighting.

2.2 The Manufacturer

Elysee Irrigation Ltd is a Cyprus based manufacturer of plastics pipeline components and supplies Holman Industries with a range of compression fittings for polyethylene pipes.

The company is involved in the Water, Irrigation, Infrastructure and Energy markets. It has more than 200 employees and services more than 65 countries with an extensive product range.

3 THE PRODUCT

This appraisal is for a range of PN16 Elysee polypropylene (PP) compression fittings for PE pipes, manufactured in conformance with AS/NZS 4129:2020 *Fittings for polyethylene (PE) pipes for pressure applications.*

The range of fittings includes couplings, tees, elbows, adaptors and end plugs in sizes from DN 16 to DN 110 and are suitable for use with PE100 pipes manufactured in accordance with AS/NZS 4130, for conveyance of drinking water, non-drinking water and sewerage in

The range of fittings includes couplings, tees, elbows, adaptors and end plugs in sizes from DN 16 to DN 110. The male and female adaptors incorporate $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 4" BSP threaded outlets depending on size. The female threaded outlets for sizes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to 4" have a Grade 430 Stainless Steel reinforcing ring. (See Section 12 for further details).

See Appendix A for details of the fittings range.

Elysee PP compression fittings are removable and suitable for reuse. The nuts of the compression fitting are generally tightened by hand for sizes DN 16 to DN 63 whilst a special wrench supplied by Holman is recommended for tightening sizes DN 75 to DN 110.

4 SCOPE OF THE APPRAISAL

The scope of this appraisal is for a range of Elysee polypropylene (PP) compression fittings for PE pipes in sizes DN 16 to DN 110 as described in Section 3, detailed in Appendix A and included in the ISO Type 5 StandardsMark Product Certification schedule referenced in Appendix B.

5 APPRAISAL CRITERIA

5.1 Quality Assurance Requirements

The WSAA Product Appraisal Technical Advisory Group accepts PP compression fittings for PE pipes manufactured in compliance with AS/NZS 4129:2020 *Fittings for polyethylene (PE) pipes for pressure applications* and duly certified by means of an ISO Type 5 product certification scheme undertaken by a JAS-ANZ accredited Conformity Assessment Body (CAB) or by an international accreditation system recognised by JAS-ANZ.

The manufacturer is generally expected to have a production management and control system that has been duly accredited in accordance with AS/NZS ISO 9001 as a prerequisite to undergoing a product certification audit.

The ISO Type 5 Product Certification Scheme shall meet the criteria described in WSA TN-08.

5.2 **Performance Requirements**

Elysee PP compression fittings have been appraised for compliance with AS/NZS 4129:2020 *Fittings for polyethylene (PE) pipes for pressure applications.*

Appraisal criteria are also determined by the WSAA Product Appraisal Technical Advisory Group and regularly reviewed to ensure that the criteria reflect the requirements of WSAA members.

The following Product Specification is also relevant to this application:

WSA PS 208 – Plastics Fittings for Pressure Applications with PE Pipe – Drinking Water, Non-Drinking Water Supply and Sewerage

6 COMPLIANCE WITH APPRAISAL CRITERIA

6.1 Compliance with Quality Assurance Requirements

Holman has submitted the following quality certificates:

- ISO 9001:2015 Certificate of Registration No. QS.2.98.060 issued to Elysee Irrigation Ltd by Cyprus Certification Company.
- AS/NZS 4129:2020 ISO Type 5 StandardsMark Product Certification Licence No. SMK26038 issued to Elysee Irrigation Ltd by SAI Global.

Copies of the Quality Assurance and Product Certification licences have been included in Appendix B and are also available from WSAA.

6.2 Compliance with Performance Requirements

6.2.1 Materials

The fitting body, nut and insert is moulded from UV stabilised polypropylene block copolymer (PP-B), which is included in AS/NZS 4129.

Holman has identified the compound as Borealis polypropylene BA160E-8229-01. A Data Sheet is held on file by WSAA.

The split ring is moulded from Polyacetal (POM) copolymer resin and is included in AS/NZS 4129.

The O-ring seal is manufactured by Duram Industries AC Ltd in Israel from NBR-70 elastomer which is covered by an ISO Type 5 KiwaMark Product Certification. A copy of the certification is held on file by WSAA.

6.2.2 Threads

The BSP male and female threads comply with ISO 7.1. Male threads are tapered, female threads smaller than 3" are parallel, and larger size female threads are tapered.

6.2.3 Type tests

Test reports completed by the Austrian Research Institute for Chemistry and Technology (OFI) (Accreditation Austria Accreditation No.0928) and Kiwa (Accredia Accreditation No. 001L) have been submitted to demonstrate compliance of the Elysee fittings to the performance requirements of AS/NZS 4129:2020. These tests include a body fitting test and tests on assembled joints to demonstrate compliance to leak-tightness under internal pressure for both short term and long term, leak-tightness under negative pressure, leak-tightness under internal pressure when the joint is subjected to bending and resistance to pull out.

6.2.4 Suitability for contact with water

Test report number 356842 dated 30 September 2022, undertaken by Australian Water Quality Centre (NATA Accreditation No. 1115) has been submitted to demonstrate compliance of the Elysee compression fittings to AS/NZS 4020:2018.

7 FITTING INSTRUCTIONS, TRAINING AND INSTALLATION

Assembly instructions are included in Appendix A.

8 PRODUCT MARKING

Product marking is in conformance with AS/NZS 4129:2020 as follows:

- (a) Manufacturers name: Elysee or Holman
- (b) Date or batch code: e.g., 2/23 (indicating run no 2 in 2023)
- (c) Nominal size: e.g., 50 mm
- (d) Material identification: PP-B
- (e) Classification: PN16
- (f) Number of the Standard: AS/NZS 4129

(a), (c) and (e) are moulded on the body of the fitting and complete information is provided on the packaging. See Figure 2.

9 PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION

The fittings are packed in transparent protective bags before packing into cardboard cartons. Each bag and/or carton is labelled with its contents. The cartons are then packed onto pallets and shrink wrapped for transportation.

10 PRODUCT WARRANTY

The products are covered by the normal commercial and legal requirements of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth)*, which covers manufacture to the relevant standard, and details of Holman's warranty is included in their terms and conditions of sale.

11 WATER AGENCY EXPERIENCE WITH THE PRODUCT OR FIELD-TESTING REPORT

Polypropylene compression fittings are a widely installed and mature product approved for use by many water agencies.

12 DISCUSSION

The Grade 430 stainless steel reinforcing ring used for the female threaded components is regarded as having 'good' corrosion resistance. WSAA nominates Grade 316 stainless steel for buried situations to provide a high level of corrosion resistance. Grade 430 stainless steel is adequate for most buried situations however agencies should be aware of the ground conditions and avoid installation in aggressive soil environments. A high resistivity sand or granular embedment is recommended to minimise the likelihood of corrosion.

Note: A high resistivity material is defined as one that has a resistivity greater than 50 ohmmeters when tested in accordance with AS 1289.4.4.1:1997 *Methods of testing soils for engineering purposes Soil chemical tests - Determination of the electrical resistivity of a soil - Method for sands and granular materials.*

The purpose of the stainless-steel reinforcement ring used in female threaded outlets is to increase hydraulic and mechanical strength of the thread, especially in the presence of high pressure and mechanical stress of the outlet, e.g., continuous vibration to the threaded connection or an oversized male thread connection. For thread sizes $1\frac{1}{2}$ " - 4" a reinforcement ring is important as the plastic thickness is proportionally smaller while the integral pressure stress applied to the thread is greater than the smaller sizes. Such rings are not required for compression fittings with female threads of sizes $\frac{1}{2}$ " - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " as the plastic thickness of the outlet has the hydraulic and mechanical strength to resist the pressure and mechanical stress.

The majority of female threaded compression fittings installed by Australian Water Agencies are small sizes ($\frac{1}{2}$ " - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ") which do not require a stainless-steel reinforcement ring to cope with hydraulic and mechanical strength needed for the various applications such as smaller reticulation water mains, property service connections, pressure sewerage networks and treatment plants.

PP compression fittings rely on interface pressure being maintained between the elastomeric seal and the PE pipe surface to maintain a sealed joint. Mechanical fittings, including compression fittings, are normally used on PE pipe \leq DN 110. Mechanical fittings are also normally used for repairs or changes to the pipeline as the pipe surface preparation requirements are less stringent than fusion welding methods (i.e., electrofusion or butt).

13 OUTCOMES OF EXPERT PANEL PRODUCT REVIEW

No issues were raised.
